

General Student Body Constitution

1. Each student enrolled at Union Theological College is a member of the General Student Body (GSB).
 2. A General Student Committee (GSC) shall be elected at a meeting of the General Student Body, at the beginning of the academic year.
 3. The Committee shall comprise the following representatives;
 - 2 undergraduates representing 1st year students
 - 2 undergraduates representing 2nd year students
 - 2 undergraduates representing 3rd year students
 - 2 representatives for postgraduate / mature students
 - 2 representatives for evening class students
 4. The Committee shall appoint a Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer and Sports Officer, and any other officers that may be desirable.
 5. The Committee shall have responsibility for;
 - Organising occasional sports / social events for Union students.
 - Liaising with Faculty on matters relating to student / College life.
 6. The Committee shall have a bank account. The signature of the Treasurer and one of (Chairperson / Secretary / Sports Officer) shall be required to draw cheques. The Treasurer shall prepare annual accounts and submit them to the Committee.
 7. The Committee shall seek the approval of Faculty for any proposed events using the name 'Union College'.
 8. Any event organised by the Committee shall be in keeping with the standards of the Presbyterian Church in Ireland.
 9. The GSC and / or the GSB may from time to time adopt standing orders for the conduct of business.
 10. A two-thirds majority at a meeting of the General Student Body, and the approval of Faculty shall be required to amend the above Constitution.
 11. The General Student Body shall meet at least once a term. An extraordinary meeting may be called, in term time, at the request of five members of the General Student Body. Such a request should be presented to the Chairperson, in writing at least one week prior to any proposed meeting.
